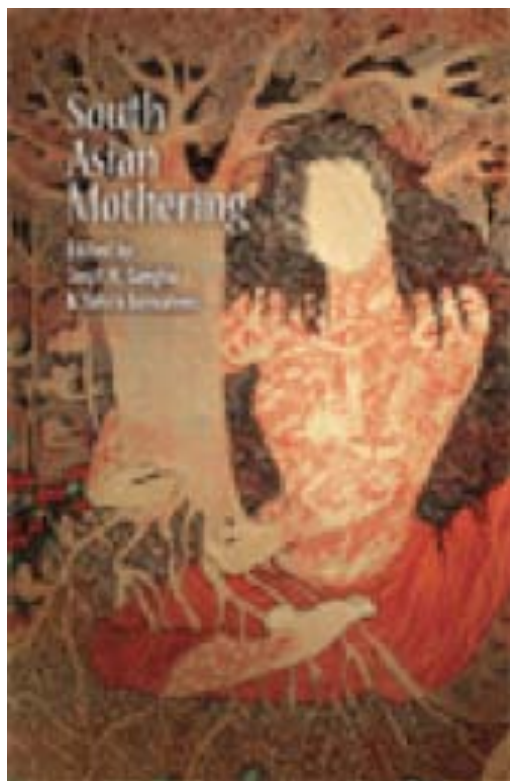

This edited collection seeks to initiate a dialogue on South Asian Mothering and how embedded cultural practices inform, shape and influence South Asian mothers' perceptions and practices of mothering. Drawing from a diverse collection of articles, this work will explore how social constructions such as gender, race, class, sexuality and ability intersect with migration and tradition both in South Asia and in the South Asian diaspora. This book will appeal to multiple audiences as contributors with backgrounds in academia, activism, public policy, and the media will draw from theory, research and lived experiences to illuminate the complexity of South Asian mothering.

Jasjit K. Sangha completed her PhD from the University of Toronto. She has been working on issues related to mothering for nearly a decade, exploring how (step) mothers engage in transformative adult learning through the process of (step) mothering. This academic work is complemented by the work she has conducted in her community with South Asian mothers. She has organized parental engagement activities specifically targeting South Asian mothers with the purpose of increasing their participation in the school and bringing culturally diverse experiences to the forefront in educational spaces.

Tahira Gonsalves has a master's degree in Sociology (Queen's University) and has completed course work towards a PhD in the same, at York University. She has an extensive background in research in the fields of international development, social and economic policy analysis, and the immigrant and mental health sectors in Canada. She has worked at the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) in Ottawa, under whose auspices she conducted fieldwork in Sri Lanka, on the role of female combatants in the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE). She has also worked for the Canadian Research Institute for the Advancement of Women (CRIAOW), and presently works for the Ontario provincial government.
