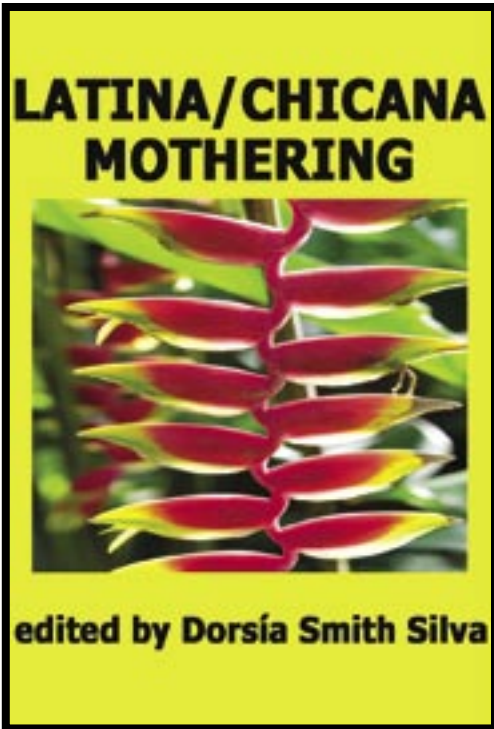

Here, the Latina/Chicana mothering experience emphasizes the need for various conceptualizations of mothering, especially in regard to the conditions which shape the lives of Latinas and Chicanas, such as race, gender, sexuality, culture, language, social status, religion, kinship, location, and migration. As the essays in this book unfold, they reveal new images of motherhood and offer ways to transform Latina / Chicana mothering. This is a great beginning and takes us a major step forward.

Dorsía Smith Silva is an Assistant Professor of English at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras. She is the co-editor of *Caribbean without Borders: Caribbean Literature, Language and Culture* (2008) and *Critical Perspectives on Caribbean Literature and Culture* (2011). Her work has appeared in several journals, including *Journal of the Association for Research on Mothering*, *Journal of Caribbean Literature*, and *La Torre* and her primary interests are ethnic mothering and mother and daughter relationships.
